THIS FACILITY PRODUCED OVER **120,000** **BLOCKS** (PULLEYS) ANNUALLY FOR THE ROYAL NAVY



PRODUCTION

BLOCKS ARE RELATIVELY SIMPLE THEIR PRODUCTION USING MANUAL METHODS WAS **SLOW AND EXACTING**

BLOCKS WERE MADE ON THREE SETS OF MACHINES (**SMALL, MEDIUM AND LARGE**) IN LOTS
